A gentle touch gives locals a good reason to visit La Chelé medical aesthetics in New Hope.

She is known for her warm personality, skill and professionalism, while her New Hope-based practice, La Chelé Medical Aesthetics LLC, has a reputation for providing some of the finest medical-grade skin care, noninvasive/nonsurgical treatments and procedures in the area.

Originally from Los Angeles, Dr. Espinoza initially focused her discipline and dedication on dance and performed with the Joffrey Ballet, among others, before pursuing her passion for medicine. She earned her master's and then a medical degree from the Drexel College of Medicine in Philadelphia. After obtaining advanced residency training, acting as chief resident, she went on to work for Hunterdon Medical Center in Flemington, N.J.

"I don't tell my patients what is 'wrong'—everyone is beautiful," she says. "Instead I ask, 'What bothers you?' ... My patients don't want to look 'frozen'—just softer."

There are many reasons patients choose to have nonsurgical procedures: Noninvasives allow patients to delay more drastic measures; the effects are often reversible; and the treatments are more affordable than traditional surgery. Many first-time clients simply come to Dr. Espinoza seeking answers and advice on skin care. La Chelé Medical Aesthetics will provide a complimentary consultation, including skin analysis, to discuss available options and educate patients about the different courses of treatment.

In addition to carrying physician-only skin-care lines, La Chelé Medical Aesthetics uses advanced techniques in facial rejuvenation and contouring, hair removal, vein treatment, body shaping, facial treatments and waxing. In addition, the practice offers the "Skin Care Club," a membership which allows patients to choose monthly treatments customized to the time of year and one's personal skin-care needs

It's just that sort of individual attention that patients of La Chelé Medical Aesthetics appreciate. Dr. Espinoza gets to know patients personally; they have her cell number, e-mail address and are encouraged to contact her directly with any concerns. The practice's staff is equally dedicated to the practice.
